- The total penalty for late filing of the inheritance tax return is fifty cents (\$.50) per day for each day the return is delinquent up to a maximum of fifty dollars (\$50) pursuant to Ind. Code §§6-4.1-4-1 and 6.
- The description of all Indiana real property owned by the decedent at the time of death is attached hereto as Exhibit A and made a part hereof as if included herein.
