

NOTICE

PURSUANT TO NEVADA ARBITRATION RULE 17(C):

No amended award shall be filed by the arbitrator, but for good cause the arbitrator may file with the arbitration commissioner and serve on the parties a request to amend the award, as long as such request is filed within twenty (20) days from the date of service of the original award.

(1) If the arbitration commissioner decides an amended award is warranted, the commissioner will issue, file and serve such amended award.

(2) Upon the issuance of an amended arbitration award, the time for requesting a trial de novo pursuant to Rule 18, or notifying a prevailing party to enter judgment pursuant to Rule 19 will begin anew upon service on the parties. Any request for a trial de novo filed before an amended arbitration award is issued shall be rendered ineffective by the amended award.

CERTIFICATE OF MAILING

Pursuant to Nevada Arbitration Rule 18(A), you are hereby notified you have thirty (30) days from the date you are served with this document within which to file a written request for trial de novo with the Clerk of the Court and serve the arbitration commissioner and all other parties.

The amended arbitration award is deemed served three (3) days after the Commissioner's designee deposits a copy of the Amended Award in the U.S. Mail.
